## 2012 Summer Course for Teenagers Ages 13-17

June 17<sup>th</sup> 2012 – Sept 2nd 2012

- Students arrive in on a Sunday, and begin the school on Monday
- Departure day is normally a Sunday
- 2 weeks minimum booking
- Lessons are Monday – Friday, 20 X 45 minute lessons per week
- 15 students per class maximum – in multinational classes
- Host Family (homestay) accommodation, shared room, all meals
- Host families are 2 sharing a room, with 4 students maximum per family. Families are within walking distance of the school.
- Host families will meet the students on arrival at the coach station in Torquay, and take them to the coach station on the departure day.
- On the first day of school, the host family will take the students to the school.
- Social Activity program with 5 afternoon activities/trips  
2 evening activities + 1 full day excursion per week
- Course materials
- Welcome pack including school bag, local information and map
- End of course certificate
- End of course teacher's report
- 24 hour emergency support

## **Accompanied Transfers for individuals or small groups <15 students Heathrow Airport (London)**

**Arrival dates: 17/06, 24/06, 01/07, 8/07, 15/07, 22/07, 29/07, 05/08, 12/08**

**Departure dates: 01/07, 08/07, 15/07, 22/07, 29/07, 05/08, 12/08, 19/08, 26/08**

On all above dates, there will be a Riviera English School leader for the transfer from/to Heathrow Airport to meet and travel with the arriving/departing students. The leader will meet students at arrivals with a name board, and help with the check-in on departure. This is referred to as an "accompanied transfer"

Earliest flight arrival: 11.00 Latest flight arrival: 15.30 (Our leader will be at Heathrow from 11.00, so any students arriving on flights arriving before this time would have to wait alone)

Earliest flight departure: 12.30 Latest flight departure: 17.00 (Our leader will be at Heathrow until 16.30, so for later flights, students would have to wait alone).

The cost for an accompanied transfer is as follows:

**£60 each way** (Heathrow-Torquay or Torquay-Heathrow) **£120 return**

Individuals with early arrivals or late departures may have to stay with our leaders at the airport whilst other students are met or checked in. Our leaders will take good care of them during this time.

For flights arriving earlier or later than times shown above will require a "meet and greet service" especially if students are aged under 16 years. Please ask the school for the cost of this when you know the flight times.

For transfer information for arrivals/departures from airports other than Heathrow, please contact the school.
